

May Gas Supply Charge

Beginning May 1st, your cost of gas will decrease from \$0.4919 per therm to \$0.4343 per therm. Last year's off-peak-season price in May 2022 was \$0.6479 per therm. If your bill contains any gas usage prior to May 1st, your cost of gas will reflect pricing from both periods. The cost of gas is a straight pass-through cost in which Liberty makes no profit.

Also beginning May 1, 2023, customer bills will reflect a per therm charge associated with the monthly decoupling adjustment in connection with the Department of Public Utilities pricing structure mandate to promote energy efficiency. Residential bills will reflect a rate of \$0.0672 per therm, customer bills in 40 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0719 per therm, and customer bills in the 50 series rate classes will reflect a rate of \$0.0142 per therm.
